Dear Riverfront Property Owner:

We are proud to have the James River as a valuable resource in our region. Each year volunteers and organizations join together in an effort to spruce up the bays, rivers, lakes and streams across this country. On Saturday, June 14, 2008 from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m., the James River Advisory Council partnering with the Chesapeake Bay Foundation will sponsor an event to keep the James River and its watershed a naturally pristine treasure.

The annual James River Regional Cleanup is the most ambitious one-day cleanup in Central Virginia. I have enclosed the summary results of the 2007 cleanup. Fortunately with support from local - government agencies, organizations, local businesses and riverfront owners like you, more than 800 volunteers register to clean up litter along the river's shorelines, islands, park areas and tributary streams. The 2008 event will focus on more than 60 miles of the James River, from Appomattox and Buckingham counties to Charles City County. Efforts involve boaters, canoeists, kayakers, hikers, waders and sorters of recyclable items.

66% decrease from 2006 Cleanup in the amount of aluminum taken from the James River.

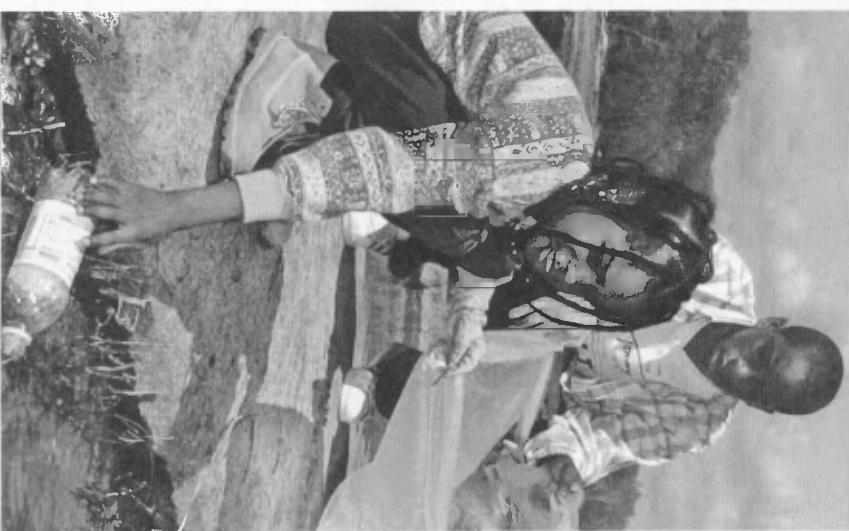
